Our Key Initiatives




According to our constitution, every child has a right to get free and compulsory education. But, the grassroots reality tells us something else.

69 homeless community children want to be a part of the mainstream education system and want themselves to get enrolled in the local government school but are failing due to the pressure of the mainstream society. Work for Equality is taking up this issue with the help of the education department of Khed block.

Girls do not get any opportunity to express themselves or to come out and openly talk about their issues. Through the Mi Shakti Initiative, we are reaching out to the marginalized girls and mobilizing them through the formation of Girls' Clubs. These Girls' Clubs empower more girls from their communities and villages and come forward to talk about their issues and also collectively find solutions to them. In the month of December, we held a three days residential training program to build the leadership qualities of 29 girls from 15 villages, formed 2 new Girls' Clubs, and reached out to 304 girls.


