Celebrations: during the period from October 18 to March 2019, we celebrated various events such as celebration of Savitribai Phule Birth Anniversary on 3rd Jan 2019 where our children participated in speech program. We also celebrated International Girl Child Day on 11th October 2018 where our community leaders and Adolescent girls performed street plays on “Save the Girl and Educate the Girl” at 6 communities and spread awareness on girl empowerment. This was the first time exposure for the community leaders and Adolescent girls where they shared their feeling with community very openly. We also celebrated Republic Day on 26th Jan with community parents and children. One of the parent gave

speech on “Our Constitution and our rights” children performed dance, songs before their parents, it was an energetic program for children as well as parents. Along with that we participated Republic Day ceremony organized by Inner wheel Pune North along with 7 girls and three parents. Our five girls and one boy got bicycle from inner wheel and one of the generous donor. These bicycles they are using for educational purpose which make their school journey much easy than before. We also organized and celebrated International Women’s Day program by organizing awareness sessions for the women on “Importance of saving” during the program, our Prerana Center Children made greeting cards for their mothers and gave it to them before guest. One of the parent shared “I never got such a special surprise gift from my children which today they realize only because of the coaching given by Prerana Centers.”

We also celebrated Joy of the Giving week with Schindler India Pvt Ltd Company where they donated clothes, blankets and toys for the community children. During the program our children who are dropout from school performed dance for the guest.

Livelihood Opportunity for the community women: we organized one day paper making and clothes bags training for the community women. The training was facilitated by Avabain Navrachana Sanstha. Women participated in the training, which helped to develop their confidence. After the training some of the participants are planning to start paper making bags business by their own.

Achievement of Community Leaders and Adolescent Girl Group: during the period our community leaders and Adolescent got opportunity to give interview on community radio, the program was broadcast during Navratra festival. The community Radio broadcast two episode on Anganwadi program, Prerana Centers and Adolescent group work. The community Radio staff and management inspired a lot with community leaders and Adolescent group and offer them two days visits to their center to understand functioning of Radio. Our Adolescent group visited the community Radio studio, study the function and also performed program on Radio. This was very good opportunity for them to develop their confidence and understand more career opportunities.



Advocacy with local Government to get water facility for the School: during we did advocacy with local government to provide water facility for the school children. We had three to four meeting with local elected person Mrs. Hirabai Botre and sensitize her for the need of children. We also provide them various option to get water for the children. In this process Tech Mahindra volunteers are willing to give economical support for the school.

Computer Lab for Yelwadi School: we have also done process to give computers to the Yelwadi School through Tech Mahindra Company, which will help approximately 200 children to improve their computer skills.

Rehabilitation and Reenrollment of Girls at NGO Residential Home: during the period, we provide continuous counseling support to the parents and convinced them to support for their girls education out

of that two were school dropout and one of was never enroll in the school. Jyoti Chavan age 14 years, Naina Shinde age 12 years and Naina Shinde age 8 years now part of Work for Equality's residential home and now in process of schooling.



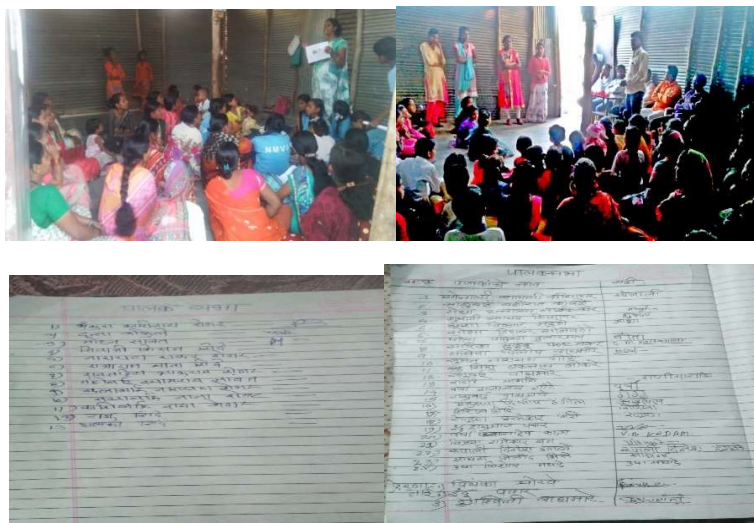
Education: through two playgroups (Anganwadi) and two Prerana Centers we are supporting more than 150 children from the community. All of them are in high risk where due to lack of educational support from parents due to poor financial condition, they need support to continue their education. Through our centers they get regular guidance to improve their study skills. We not only provide regular guidance to the children through local resource but we provide external resource to the children to improve their skills. Our teacher took initiative and done polio campaign and provide dose to all children in community



Parents Awareness: Through frequently home visits and monthly parents meeting, we try to increase awareness among marginalized parents on educational rights of children especially girls. Not only that, we also emphasize on the issues of health and hygiene, parenting with the community. During we conducted six parents meet and six individual home visits of each parents.



Community capacity building: we conducted six workshop with community to develop their sensitivity and understanding regarding child rights and related issues. These programs helped a lot to developed knowledge of community. Due to the programs they start thinking about their children future. Before the training they never asked questions but now they start to ask questions about their children.



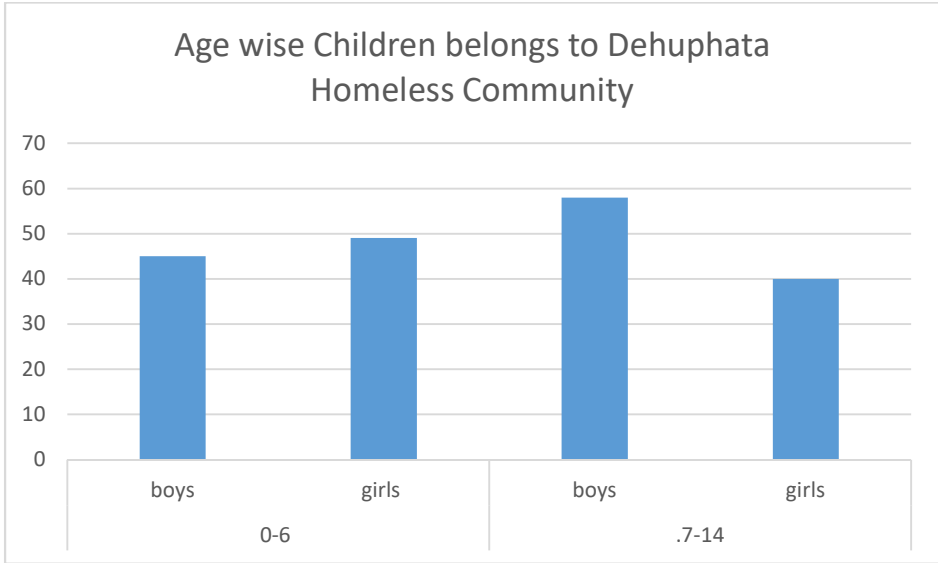
Life Skills Training program : we facilitated six life skills training program for the children during the reporting period. We focused on health and hygiene, nutrition, communication skills, saving habits, gender and prevention of sexual abuse with children. These sessions help to improve their knowledge and confidence to deal with issues.



Staff capacity building: during the period we conducted four one day and two – two days staff capacity building programs. The program was focused on to build educational capacity of staff, to learn various interactive teaching methods, teach children to ask question, parenting etc... these training program helped staff to developed their sensitivity and knowledge about children and related issues.



Educational status of the community: during the period, we did survey of the community and understand the educational status of the children. We found day by day number of homeless community people are increasing this area. We found 192 children from the homeless community either they never enrolled at school, or school dropout or having high risk of dropout. The observation is, due to continuous migration, children unable to continue their study and loss interest in study. Parents are willing for education if they will get trustworthy shelter homes. So next phase we will more focus on the continuation of education through various support systems like government and non-government shelter homes.
